PRIVACY POLICY

This privacy policy discloses the privacy practices for Aidbox's website (<http://www.aidbox.org>). This privacy policy applies solely to information collected by this website. It will notify you of the following:

1. What personally identifiable information is collected from you through the website, how it is used, and with whom it may be shared.
2. What choices are available to you regarding the use of your data.
3. The security procedures in place to protect the misuse of your information.
4. How you can correct any inaccuracies in the information.

Registration

In order to use this website, a user must first complete the registration form. During registration a user is required to give certain information, such as name and email address. This information is used to contact you about the services on our website in which you have expressed interest. At your option, you may also provide demographic information about yourself, such as gender or age, but it is not required.

Cookies

We use "cookies" on this site. A cookie is a piece of data stored on a site visitor's hard drive to help us improve your access to our site and identify repeat visitors to our site. For instance, when we use a cookie to identify you, you would not have to log in a password more than once, thereby saving time while on our site. Cookies can also enable us to track and target the interests of our users to enhance the experience on our website. Usage of a cookie is in no way linked to any personally identifiable information on our website.

Some of our business partners may use cookies on our website (for example, advertisers). However, we have no access to or control over these cookies.

Information Collection, Use, and Sharing

We (Aidbox) are the sole owners of the information collected on this site. We only have access to and collect information that you voluntarily give us via email or other direct contact from you. We share aggregated demographic information with our partners and sponsors. This is not linked to any personal information that can identify any individual person.

We will use your information to respond to you regarding the reason you contacted us and communicate with you regarding your use of the website.

Unless you ask us not to, we may contact you via email in the future to tell you about specials, new products or services, or changes to this privacy policy.

Your Access to and Control Over Information

You may opt out of any future contacts from us at any time, except for communications regarding the compliance of your website use with our terms and conditions. You can do the following at any time by contacting us via the email address or phone number given on our website:

- See what data we have about you, if any;
- Change or correct any data we have about you;
- Have us delete any data we have about you; and
- Express any concern you have about our use of your data.

Security

We take precautions to protect your information. When you submit sensitive information via the website, your information is protected both online and offline. Wherever we collect sensitive information (such as personally identifiable information), that information is encrypted and transmitted to us in a secure way. You can verify this by looking for a closed lock icon in your web browser, or looking for “https” at the beginning of the address of the web page.

While we use encryption to protect sensitive information transmitted online, we also protect your information offline. Only employees who need the information to perform a specific job are granted access to personally identifiable information. The computers and servers in which we store personally identifiable information are kept in a secure environment.

Remember that no method of transmission over the Internet, or method of electronic storage, is 100% secure. While we strive to use commercially acceptable means to protect your information, we cannot guarantee its absolute security.

Compliance with Law and Fraud Protection

We may disclose any information we deem necessary, in our sole discretion and without your prior permission, to comply with any applicable law, regulations, legal process or governmental request. We may also exchange information with other companies and organizations for credit fraud protection, risk reduction and related activities or to protect the rights, property, or safety of Aidbox, its agents, employees or affiliates or others. Aidbox reserves the right to use and disclose to third parties the personal information of a user who we believe is in violation of our Privacy Policy or other terms as posted on our site, even without a subpoena, warrant, court order or other governmental request, to the extent we deem necessary to protect the safety, security and rights of Aidbox and of third parties.

Sale or Transfer of Information

In the event of a sale, merger, liquidation, dissolution, or sale or transfer of substantially all of the assets of Aidbox, personal information may be sold, assigned or transferred to the party acquiring all or substantially all of the equity and/or assets of Aidbox in order to permit the transferee to continue the operation of Aidbox and/or our site, or any successor version of
